

## Import Fonts From Embroidery

- Import individual embroidered letters to create a font for use on the Letter tab.

1.	<p>When you have purchased a full alphabet or several letters, you can easily import them to the software and use them exactly the same way you use the fonts included with the software.</p> <p><i>NOTE: You can not use the Library designs as .evp3 files with this feature.</i></p> <p>In this exercise we used the Thread Velvet Font that can be found in mySewnet Library.</p>	
2.	Open a Blank Canvas	<p><b>New Project:</b></p> <p> <b>Blank Canvas</b> Start a new project with no content.</p>
3.	Click on the Letter Tab and the Font Manager	
4.	On the right hand side you will find the Font Tools and Import Font From Embroideries	

5.	Choose where you want to save your font in the list, i.e My Fonts	
6.	Give the Font a name	
7.	<p>Find the folder where you have saved your collection of letters. Choose the first one to upload (A)</p> <p>In this exercise we used the Thread Velvet Font that can be found in mySewnet Library. It needs to be purchased to use the</p>	
8.	<p>The size of the letter is automatically set</p> <p>Choose the chosen Character in the list, in this case A.</p>	

<p>9.</p>	<p>Click and drag the baseline so that you get the placement correct. Right underneath the letter.</p> <p>This will get the placement right in relation to the other characters.</p>	
<p>10.</p>	<p>Click on the next letter you want to insert and upload it.</p>	
<p>11.</p>	<p>If you only have a few letters you can upload them and later go back and add more. Just select your font in the list.</p>	
<p>12.</p>	<p>Click Edit Imported Fonts and you can continue.</p>	
<p>13.</p>	<p>The new font will be found in the MyFonts Category and can be used in the same way as all the built-in fonts.</p>	

14.	This is also where you can Edit and manage your Fonts. For example if you have created a Quick Font that you want to remove. Mark the font you want to edit.	
15.	Click Delete on the right hand side	
16.	This will permanently delete the Font
