


Embellish - Decoration





Decorate your embroideries with beads, sequins and crystals.
Apply decorations to your project by exporting the design with placement stitches.

1.	As a base embroidery we used the word "STAR", size 80mm in the font Harris 2C 20-80mm, found in the Display Category	
2.	The Shape is Free Sculpt.	
3.	Create a nice shape by moving the squares.	

<p>4.</p>	<p>Go to the Embellish Tab. Choose the Decoration.</p>	
<p>5.</p>	<p>In the next step, you can choose how you want to place your Decorations:</p> <p>Place Individual - Click the placement where you want the individual decorations.</p> <p>Draw Line - Choose Freehand Line or Point Line to draw placement with a line.</p> <p>Or choose among 24 Shapes to use as placement.</p> <p>We chose Place Individual. Then you get different opinions on what your decoration would look like. It could be beads, pearls or sequins in different styles and shapes.</p>	
<p>6.</p>	<p>You can also choose the color and size you want.</p>	
<p>7.</p>	<p>If you choose a decoration with a asymmetric shape, you can also set the angle.</p>	

8.	If you choose a line or shape you can also choose the spacing in between the decorations	<div data-bbox="889 94 1409 273"> <p>Line of Decorations</p> <p>Spacing: 6.5 mm</p> <p>Rotation: <input checked="" type="radio"/> Follow Line <input type="radio"/> Stepped</p> </div>
9.	Click in the hoop area to place the decorations.	
10.	Right click to finish the placing.	

<p>11.</p>	<p>If you want to Edit placement or Properties. Click on Edit Points.</p> <p>Move the points to where you want them.</p> <p>You can also Insert Points or Delete Selection.</p>	
<p>12.</p>	<p>If you click on Properties, you can change the set up again.</p>	
<p>13.</p>	<p>The result in embroidery will be that the machine creates stitches that will mark the placement of the decorations on the projects. The actual adding is done manually after the embroidery is done.</p>	
<p>14.</p>	<p>Click on the Home Tab and click on Combine and Combine All before saving.</p>	

<p>15.</p>	<p>To save the design click on File and Save As. This will save a .vp4 file that is fully editable again if you want to continue working with it.</p>	
<p>16.</p>	<p>If you want a different format you use the Export instead.</p>	
<p>17.</p>	<p>Here you will get a list of all available formats and you can choose the format you need for your embroidery machine.</p>	
<p>18.</p>	<p>On the Export pop-up you also get additional choices under Optimize for Sewing. These are settings you can change in Configure.</p>	

19. Under File and Print, you will get the option to print a template. This is perfect if you want to experiment with the placement or see how the design aligns.

Make sure the Design Scale is set to 100%

You can choose what information you want on your template by checking/unchecking the boxes under Print Information.

Tips & Hints

When embroidering on a stretchy fabric like a sweater the best solution would be to use a sticky water soluble stabilizer. This will make sure the fabric is not stretches as it embroiders.

If you don't have that, you can also add an additional water soluble on top to keep the fabric from stretching and the embroidery to be distorted.
