<p>1.</p>	<p>Open mySewnet Embroidery. Choose Blank Canvas. In the Hoop Selection pop-up choose 240mm x 150mm Hoop. Orientation Rotated. Click OK</p>	
<p>2.</p>	<p>Go to the Lettering Tab. Here you have 245 different fonts pre-digitized.</p> <p>They can be found in different categories; Appliqué, Children, Display, Effects, Elegant, Modern etc.</p> <p>In addition to the name of the font, there is information regarding recommended size and if it says UC in the name. The font is only available in Upper Case letters.</p>	
<p>3.</p>	<p>Choose the font Astra 2C 20-100mm, in the Display Category The 2C means that the font has two colors.</p>	

<p>4.</p>	<p>Type in I LOVE in upper case letters. Set the size to 60mm. Either by using the arrow up or clicking on the number and type 60. Under the Shape, choose Pennant Left. <p>10.</p>	<p>Click on the SuperDesign Tab and the arrow on the lower right hand corner. This will make the categories visible</p>	
<p>11.</p>	<p>Scroll through the categories until you find the Hearts.</p>	
<p>12.</p>	<p>Choose the heart with the quilted look.</p>	
<p>13.</p>	<p>Set the size to 30mm and click apply.</p>	
<p>14.</p>	<p>Center the design in between the I and the L.</p>	
<p>15.</p>	<p>Click on the Home Tab. Choose Combine all to combine the design to one file.</p>	

16.	Click Color Sort to reduce the number of color changes.	
17.	<p>If you have a mySewnet enabled machine, you can send the design directly to the machine Screen, ready to be stitched out.</p> <p>The send options can be found in the top right corner of the screen.</p>	
18.	To save the design click on File and Save As. This will save a .vp4 file that is fully editable again if you want to continue working with it.	
19.	<p>If you want a different format you use the Export instead.</p> <p>Here you will get a list of</p>	

20.	Here you will get a list of all available formats and you can choose the format you need for your embroidery machine.	
21.	On the Export pop-up you also get additional choices under Optimize for Sewing. These are settings you can change in Configure.	
22.	Save
