## Lettering

Choose from 245 different fonts to personalize your project..

- Add text to your design
- Choose from 35 shape templates
- Use handles to adjust the shape of the lettering

1.	Open mySewnet Embroidery. Choose Blank Canvas. In the Hoop Selection pop-up choose 240mm x 150mm Hoop. Orientation Rotated. 2.	Go to the Lettering Tab. Here you have 245 different fonts pre-digitized. They can be found in different categories; Appliqué, Children, Display, Effects, Elegant, Modern etc. In addition to the name of the font, there is information regarding recommended size and if it says UC in the name. 3.	Choose the font Astra 2C 20-100mm, in the Display Category The 2C means that the font has two colors.	Astra 2C 20-100mm

4.	Type in I LOVE in upper case letters. Set the size to 60mm. Either by using the arrow up or clicking on the number and type 60. Under the Shape, choose Pennant Left. Click Apply	Image: Second state   Image: Second state
5.	Use the green circles in the corner to manipulate the shape so it fits in the hoop and has a straight top. The size is about 10mm smaller than the width of the hoop. (Approx. 70mm to the left and 40mm to the right.)	
6.	Click in the letter box and type in COFFEE. Leave the size as 60mm and this time choose Pennant Right. Click Apply	Reverse   Individual   Step   ColorSort   Stitch   Type*   Stitches
7.	Manipulate the text so it looks nice, this time with approx. 40mm to the left and 70mm to the right with a straight bottom edge. Note that your two lines of text appears	I LOVE COFFEE

9.	Let's add a Super Design to make it a bit more interesting. SuperDesigns are built-in designs that are digitized to work at any size and you can easily manipulate them without losing	

	shape or stitches. They are available in a vast variety of styles and themes.

17.	If you have a mySewnet enabled machine, you can send the design directly to the machine Screen, ready to be stitched out. The send options can be found in the top right corner of the screen.	-∃ × ❷
18.	To save the design click on File and Save As. This will save a .vp4 file that is fully editable again if you want to continue working with it.
