## PhotoStitch - with mySewnet App

Turn any photo into an embroidery design by simply taking a picture using the PhotoStitch Feature within the mySewnet app. It'll automatically turn it into a ready-to-stitch design that can be sent directly to your mySewnet device or be saved in your cloud account.





3	This will open the camera on your phone/tablet. Now you can take a picture to digitize. This feature will work best on clear graphic pictures.	9/41 (I)
4.	The default setting for creating a design is Scatter but there are 3 different stitch options to choose from in two sizes each. You can try which option works best for your image.	Scatter 80mm x 80mm Scatter 150mm x 150mm Satin 80mm x 80mm Satin 150mm x 150mm Line Art 80mm x 80mm

6.	There are also editing options available. You can Invert the image or use the eraser to remove object you do not want.	
7.	When you are happy with your embroidery. You can either send it directly to your mySewnet enabled machine or save it to your Cloud account for use later.
