## Software Settings

Use the Preferences and Configure to set the universal behavior and look of mySewnet Embroidery Software.

3.	Remove Overlap When Combining Embroideries: When this option is selected, overlapping areas of embroidery are removed, so that there is no build-up of stitching where embroideries overlap. This is used for the Combine All and Combine Selected functions. This option is initially selected.
