


Word Sculpt Wizard

Automatically create a design made out of words using this wizard.


- Choose from over 300 shapes
- Type in the words you want to use to fill the shape
- Select font and color options
- Sculpt the words to fit the contours of the shape
- Create your own custom shapes (requires mySewnet Platinum)

1.	Open mySewnet Embroidery. Choose Blank Canvas. In the Hoop Selection pop-up choose 260x260 Hoop. Click OK	
2.	Go to the create Tab and Word Sculpt.	


<p>3.</p>	<p>In the first step of the wizard you can select one of over 300 shapes from the drop-down list They are available in many different styles like; animals, buildings, holidays, letters etc.</p>	
<p>4.</p>	<p>Shape You can also load a shape with Open Shape, use New Shape or Edit Shape to create or edit a shape in mySewnet™ Draw & Paint.</p>	
<p>5.</p>	<p>Select Size Enter the desired size for your design.</p> <p>The default dimensions will depend upon the shape selected, and the current hoop. The minimum size for a design is 20mm and the maximum size is 2000m.</p>	
<p>6.</p>	<p>Angle Use Angle to change the angle at which the outline shape is created and displayed.</p> <p>Mirror Select the Mirror checkbox to reflect the design from left to right.</p>	

<p>7.</p>	<p>Stitch Type Select the type of outline to create around the word design from one of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Satin Line • Motif Line • Running Stitch • Triple Stitch <p>Stitch Options After selecting the type of outline, click the Stitch Options button to show the properties for that outline type. If desired, adjust the properties and click OK.</p>	
<p>8.</p>	<p>Preview A preview of the design, and its stitch count, width, height and number of color is displayed.</p>	
<p>9.</p>	<p>In the dinosaur category, choose dinosaur 2.</p>	
<p>10.</p>	<p>Use the size that is determined by the hoop size.</p>	
<p>11.</p>	<p>Leave the angle at 0 and Stitch Type to Satin</p>	
<p>12.</p>	<p>Click Next</p>	

13.	Triceratops, Brontosaurus, Velociraptor, Spinosaurus, T-Rex, Brachiosaurus	<p>Words:</p> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin-bottom: 5px;">Triceratops, Brontosaurus, Velociraptor, Spinosaurus, T-Rex, Brachiosaurus</div> <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Upper case only <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Use words only once
14.	If you do not see all words you have added, change the Font size to a smaller size and they will fit the shape and be visible. This can later be changes when you start working with the words.	<p>Margin: <input type="text" value="1 mm"/></p> <p>Font Size: <input type="text" value="8 mm"/></p>
15.	<p>Having the fonts set to random, creates a mix of fonts, that you can choose to work with or change later.</p> <p>You can also choose a specific font you want to use.</p>	<p><input checked="" type="radio"/> Random fonts <input type="radio"/> Select a font</p> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin-bottom: 5px;"> <p style="font-size: 2em; font-weight: bold; color: red;">ABCabc</p> <p>Clarendon 12-30mm</p> </div> <p>Color Theme: XXXXXX Original</p> <p>Orientation: <input type="text" value="Random"/></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><input type="button" value="Refresh Preview"/></p>
16.	Orientation can be lefty at random or set in a specific orientation. 18.	Click Finish and the design appears in the	





19.	The design is grouped	
20.	To be able to work with the different parts of the designs, click Reveal Group or Ungroup	




21. Now you have the possibility to change the separate parts/words of the design.



22. If you want to change the font, just mark the word you want to change and right click. Choose Edit Lettering.



<p>23.</p>	<p>You will be able to access all fonts available.</p>	
<p>24.</p>	<p>Continue to edit the words you have by using the handles surrounding the words.</p>	
<p>25.</p>		
<p>26.</p>	<p>To save the design click on File and Save As. This will save a .vp4 file that is fully editable again if you want to continue working with it.</p>	
<p>27.</p>	<p>If you want a different format you use the Export instead.</p>	

<p>28.</p>	<p>Here you will get a list of all available formats and you can choose the format you need for your embroidery machine.</p>	
<p>29.</p>	<p>On the Export pop-up you also get additional choices under Optimize for Sewing. These are settings you can change in Configure.</p>	
<p>30.</p>	<p>If you open Configure under the File menu and the Export Tab you can select your options. Removing the checkmarks for Combine and Color Sort helps if you want to decide when to do that manually before Export.</p> <p>This is very useful when working with Appliqué designs where you want to keep the number of color blocks for the technique steps.</p> <p>When you have made the changes click Apply and OK.</p>

Under File and Print, you will get the option to print a template. This is perfect if you want to experiment with the placement or see how the design aligns.

Make sure the Design Scale is set to 100%

You can choose what information you want on your template by checking/unchecking the boxes under Print Information.
