<p>7.</p>	<p>There is also the possibility to Filter by Design Size if you are looking for a specific minimum or maximum size or Color Block Count, which is very useful if you are looking for a monochrome design etc.</p>	
<p>8.</p>	<p>Filter on Flowers and find one that you like. This is #100443003</p>	
<p>9.</p>	<p>You will see the Name given to the design.</p> <p>The file name, which is what will show when you save or send the design.</p> <p>Number of colors and stitches,</p> <p>Height and width.</p>
