


Oilcloth Table Runner




Create a custom table runner for your kitchen or patio table using oilcloth. The geometric arc design can be added to the ends of the runner, no matter what length of runner you need. Your table will have an extra level of protection while looking beautiful. The width of the finished table runner is 20" (50cm).

What you need


- Oil Cloth
- Standard Grip Mat 24" x 24"
- Basic Blade
- Brayer
- Ruler
- Rotary Cutter

Directions

- 1. Cut a piece of oilcloth 22" (56cm) wide and as long as you want your table runner to be. The cut-out arc pattern at the end is 14 inches (35.5cm) long.
- Open the project in Canvas. Place one end of the 22" wide (56cm) material centered on your 24" mat. Let the length of the fabric hang out from the mat. Use a Brayer to help adhere the material to the cutting mat, eliminating wrinkles or bubbles.
- Go to the Output Menu and press Send to Machine. Follow the steps to cut the material on your crafting machine.



4. Place the other end of the material on the mat and center it the same way as the first.



5. Use a ruler and rotary cutter to neaten and trim the edges between the scallop end designs.
